Welcome to our 2025 Bulb Catalogue.

It is joyful to write after such a brilliant spring - so many of you sent photos of your tulip displays radiant in the glorious spring sunshine and flowering for weeks on end. Excellent news from Holland that harvests are up which results in plumper bulbs, but that hasn't yet translated into lower bulb prices, (indeed some varieties are eye-wateringly pricy!). So with this in mind we're focusing on sustainability with bulbs that come back year after year, and suggesting perhaps just a few well-placed pots of tulips that will receive compliments and fill your hearts full of cheer after the darkest winter months.


I don't think there was a single bulb that didn't flourish in the sunny weather, but I did have to water my tulip pots before they fully flowered and I suspect this will become a more regular occurrence. **Tulip Cabanna** (p.20) stood out for us - flowering for weeks on end and making an excellent, long-lasting cut flower for the vase. Narcissi, especially **Replete** (p.11), **Acropolis** (p.8) and **Winston Churchill** (p.11) provided bunch after bunch of cut flowers....


Bulbs planted several years ago popped up in unexpected places hence the reintroduction of **Ornithogalum nutans** (p.43) - such a ghostly sight - and **Scilla mischtschenkoana** (p.40) since it provided very early bee food.

New Additions and Introductions

Narcissi: We've gone to town on new varieties and Sabina has finally added the long coveted **Salome** (p.13) to the selection, with its elegant peach-pink trumpet. Also, our first miniature narcissus **Snow Baby** (p.38), small but perfectly formed.

Tulips: Hands-up it was me, rather than Sabina, who this time got over-excited when ordering the tulips. So, let's welcome to the party: Tabledance (p.21), Orange Princess (p.27), Double Sugar (p.27), Black Hero (p.25), Jimmy (p.18), Light & Dreamy (p.21), Candy Club (p.21) and others - not forgetting T. clusiana Peppermint Stick (p.29).









'Marilyn' (50 - 60 cm) as seen here in her 15th year - reliable perennial lily-flowered tulip.


